**Second Collection for the Catholic Home
Missions and the Black and Indian
Missions on April 27 and 28, 2024**



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On the weekend of April 27 and 28, our Archdiocese will take up the national collection for the Catholic Home Missions and the Black and Indian Missions.

Our Catholic faith is one of beauty and hope, mercy and joy. But for too many people across the country, there are few opportunities to learn about and deepen that faith. Even the most basic programs are out of reach because of fragile financial situations, tough terrain, or small populations of Catholics. One does not need to go far to find mission territory: it is right here at home.

Nearly half of our country is considered home mission territory. This appeal strengthens the Catholic Church in the United States and its territories where resources are thin and priests are few. Proceeds are distributed as grants to dioceses supporting and strengthening evangelization programs which would otherwise be in danger of disappearing among the Black and American Indian communities.

Your support helps these Mission Dioceses form vibrant faith communities and strengthens the Church at home. Monies are used for a wide range of pastoral services including evangelization, religious education, and maintenance of mission parishes, the training of seminarians and lay ministers, and ministry with ethnic groups. I can speak to this personally, having written extensively about the missions during my doctoral studies and wrote my dissertation titled "Catholics and the Missions of the Pacific Northwest." My time in Helena, Montana as Bishop further solidified this understanding, serving in a Mission Diocese before coming to serve the vibrant community here in Las Vegas.

Please be generous, and prayerfully consider how you can support this collection.

Católicas en el Hogar y las Misiones
Negras e Indias el 27 y 28 de abril de
2024**



Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en Cristo,

El fin de semana del 27 y 28 de abril, nuestra Diócesis tomará la colecta nacional para las Misiones Católicas en el Hogar y las Misiones Negras e Indias.

Nuestra fe católica es de hermosura, esperanza, misericordia y alegría. Pero para demasiadas personas en todo el país, hay pocas oportunidades para aprender y profundizar esa fe. Incluso los programas más básicos están fuera de su alcance debido a situaciones financieras frágiles, terreno áspero o pequeñas poblaciones de católicos. Uno no necesita ir muy lejos para encontrar el territorio de la misión: está aquí en casa.

Casi la mitad de nuestro país se considera territorio de misión de origen. Este llamamiento fortalece a la Iglesia Católica en los Estados Unidos y sus territorios donde los recursos son escasos y los sacerdotes son pocos. Las ganancias se distribuyen como subvenciones a las diócesis que apoyan y fortalecen los programas de evangelización que de otro modo estarían en peligro de desaparecer entre las comunidades negras e indígenas americanas.

Su apoyo ayuda a estas Diócesis de la Misión a formar comunidades de fe vibrantes y fortalece a la Iglesia en casa. Los fondos se utilizan para una amplia gama de servicios pastorales, incluida la evangelización, la educación religiosa y el mantenimiento de parroquias misioneras, la capacitación de seminaristas y ministros laicos y el ministerio con grupos étnicos. Puedo hablar de esto personalmente, ya que escribí extensamente sobre las misiones durante mis estudios de doctorado y escribí mi tesis titulada "Los católicos y las misiones del noroeste del Pacífico". Mi tiempo en Helena, Montana, como Obispo, solidificó aún más este entendimiento, sirviendo en una Diócesis de la Misión antes de venir a servir a la vibrante comunidad aquí en Las Vegas.

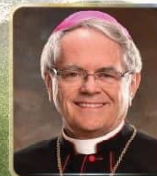

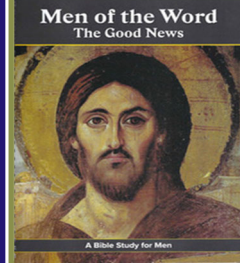
